The Achievement Gap is at the Top

Portland Public Schools data illustrating the differences in achievement gains among Low Income and Minority students who are at the "low" level of achievement and those who are at the "exceeds" level of achievement.

A comparison of the tables and charts show that the achievement gap is much smaller at the "low" end of the scale than among the students who "exceed".

Data reporting that does not include achievement levels will not capture this problem.




